2. Results: Content and technical specification of the process of micro-credentialization.

The technical specification of the process of micro-credentialization includes:

- a template model of the digital and micro-credential and its meta-data fields;
- a template of open learning opportunity (course) description that is harmonized with and meta-data fields;
- both are matched with the European union digital infrastructure for micro-credentials.





3 Results: Compilation of documents for the open learning environment ready for the process of micro-credentialization.

Open learning environment technically adapted and prepared to issue micro-credentials:

- adapting learning opportunity description form following content and technical specification,
- preparing a prototype of university micro-credential.





4. Results: The piloting record of digital and micro-credentials issuing process.

- registering the descriptions of learning opportunities (courses) in the *Europass*,
- piloting the issuing of micro-credential for at least 5 courses as open learning opportunities.

- 4 • Digital metadata template
- 5 • Virtual learning environment (VLE)

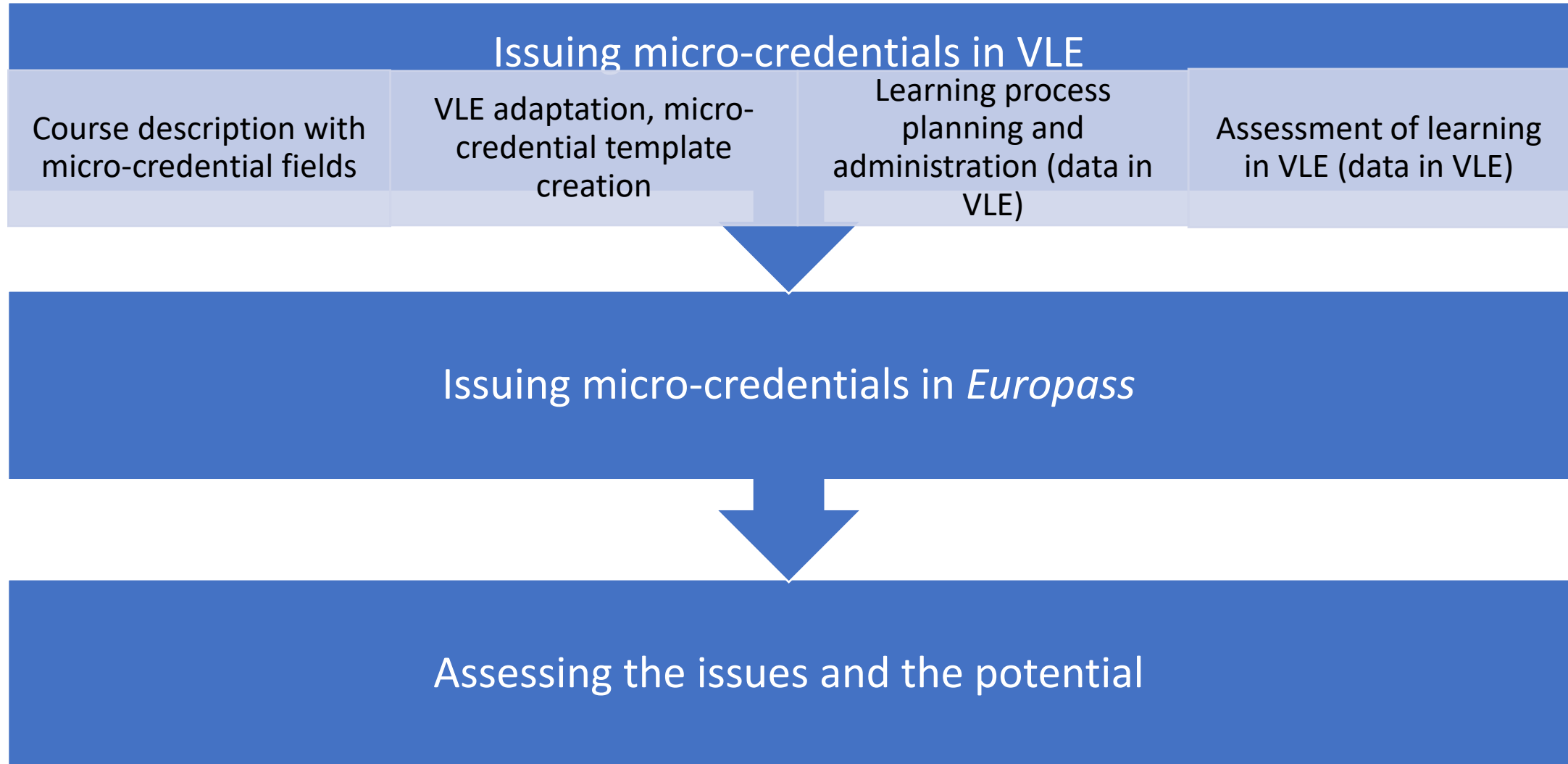
